**SELECTION:**

- Entries will be judged by the MSED A Education Committee and Jenn O'Neill.
- The judges will be familiar with eventing but not necessarily a competitor, rider or instructor. A judge cannot be a relative of the applicant or involved with the applicant as an instructor or coach.
- The recipient will be awarded a check and certificate during the awards dinner in December at the MSED A Annual Meeting and Awards Banquet.

**RECIPIENT'S RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- The recipient must keep a record of their activity and from this share their experience with other riders in the form of an article to be published in the MSED A Newsletter and Social Media outlets.
